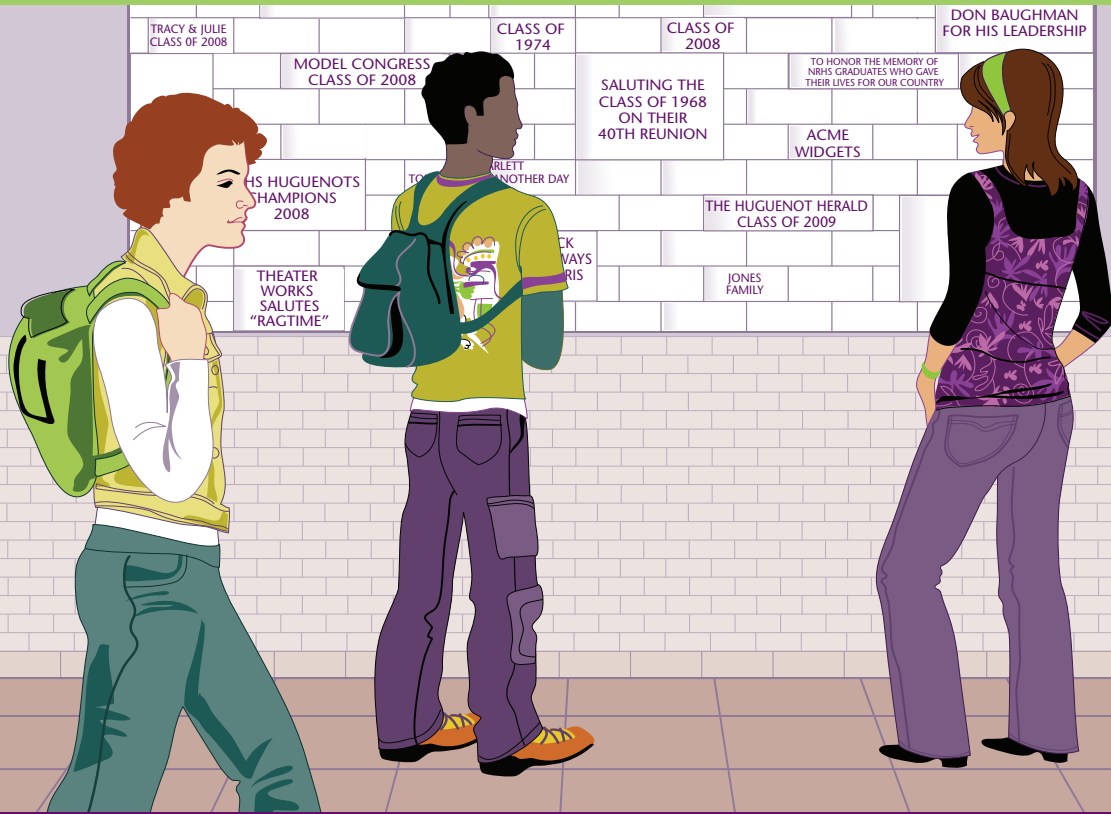


MAC Legacy Wall

Purchasing a Tile

Personalized tiles can honor a special teacher (*Thank You, Mr. Chips*), memorialize a loved one (*In Memory of Joe Smith, Class of 1929*), mark a special milestone such as a graduation (*Class of 2008*) or anniversary (*25th Anniversary, Class of 1983*), celebrate a favorite club (*French Club supports the Arts*), activity (*Model Congress, Best Delegation 2008*) or achievement (*State Champions 2004*), or serve as a permanent reminder of special supporters (*The Jones Family*).

When you purchase a personalized tile, your tax-deductible contribution supports the Museum of Arts & Culture, a program of the non-profit New Rochelle Fund for Educational Excellence. The MAC is the only Regents-chartered museum in a school in New York State; it is open to the public and features both traveling exhibits and shows of student art. Your support will help keep the MAC open for generations to come.

The white ceramic tiles are available in three sizes.

SIZE	COST	ENGRAVING
Standard 8" x 4"	\$250	Three lines, 15 characters each
Medium 8" x 8"	\$500	Six lines, 15 characters each
Large* 12" x 12"	\$1,500	Up to ten lines, 15 characters each

Each size tile can be engraved with the message you choose, incised into the surface and colored purple. Each line of text consists of 15 characters, including spaces and punctuation. The MAC reserves the right to refuse any inscription requests that are deemed inappropriate, including vulgar or hurtful language.

Orders will be accepted until MARCH 31, 2009. Once your order and payment have been received, you'll get an acknowledgement letter and a certificate (suitable for framing or gift-giving) that bears the inscription as it will appear on the tile. You will also be invited to a ribbon cutting ceremony when the wall is installed in 2009.

* Purchasers of large size tiles will also receive a replica tile for display in home or office.
